KEY FACTORS THAT AFFECT PRICING



TYPE OF TEST

Different types of DNA tests vary in complexity and the analysis required.



NUMBER OF PEOPLE TESTED

The more individuals involved, the higher the cost of the test.



SAMPLE TYPE

Buccal swabs are standard. Blood or other specialized samples may cost more.



TURNAROUND TIME

Standard results take longer. Expedited or rush results cost more.



TESTING TECHNOLOGY

Advanced technology and more DNA markers increase accuracy and cost.



LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Court-admissible testing requires strict procedures and detailed documentation.



ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Services like shipping, reports, consultation, or legal affidavits may add to cost.

STANDARD vs. EXPEDITED TESTING



STANDARD TESTING

- Most affordable option
- Results in 3–7 business days (depending on test)
- Ideal when time is not urgent



EXPEDITED & RUSH TESTING

- Faster results in 24–72 hours
- Additional fee applies
- Best for urgent or time-sensitive cases
